



SEPTEMBER HONORS THE WORK. HURRICANE SEASON DEMANDS THE PREP

This Labor Day, we're thinking about the people who keep water and gas systems running — the contractors, engineers, and installers who do the work most people never see until something goes wrong.

September is also National Preparedness Month, and it lands right at the peak of hurricane season. That makes it a good time to build a valve check into every fall service call — for your customers' sake, and for your own peace of mind on the next storm system.

Checklist:

- Confirm the gas shut-off valve is accessible and clearly labeled
- Test that it turns freely, without excessive force
- Inspect for corrosion, wear, or mineral buildup
- Confirm certification (CSA / UL / NSF) on older valves
- Flag any valve that needs replacing before the next storm passes through

Help your customers stay ready before the next system moves through.

Know your shut-off before the storm.

- ✓ Locate the main shut-off
- ✓ Make sure the handle turns
- ✓ Inspect for corrosion
- ✓ Clear access around the valve
- ✓ Show everyone where it is
